I love spending time with my family, sports and music. I aspire to share my passion for music with the kids through Kapa haka.

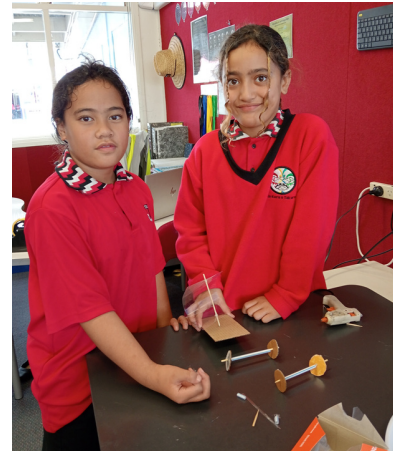

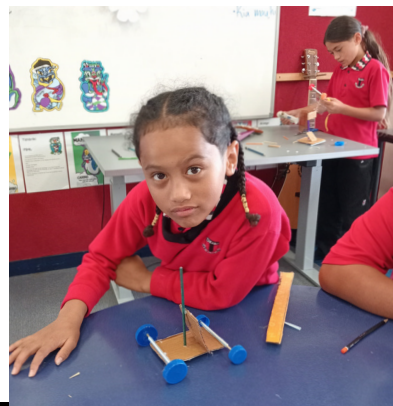

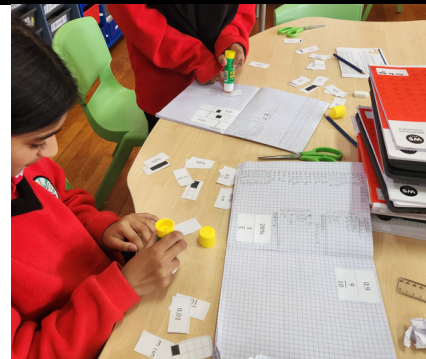
We have also been enjoying swimming, team sports, and writing our own autobiographies!

MĀHURI TŌTARA

In Māhuri Tōtara we have been working hard in mathematics. This week we started exploring the Big Idea - Decimals, fractions and percentages are closely related. Decimals are another way of writing fractions. Percentages are another way of writing hundredths. We practiced matching decimals, fractions, and percentages before we worked on a task that we needed to be able to use all of the skills and strategies we have practised so far this year.
